

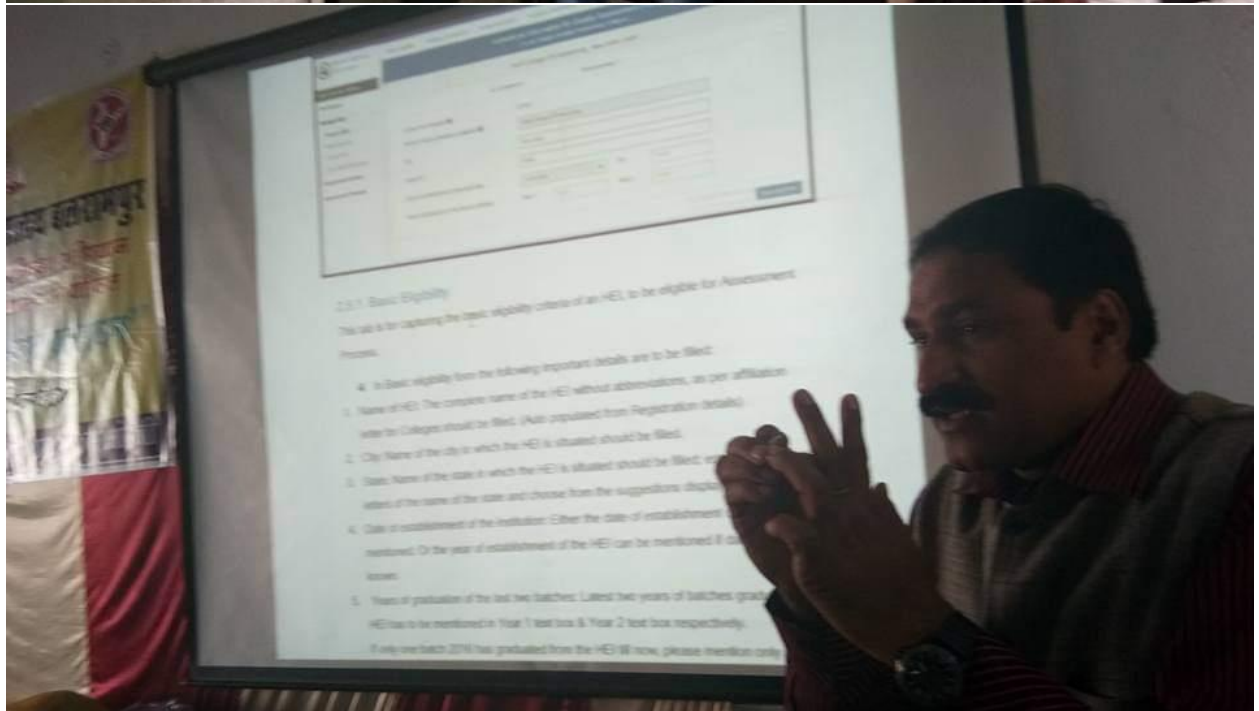

2.3.1 Basic Eligibility
The aim is to capture the basic eligibility criteria of an HEI, to be eligible for Assessment Process.

4. In Basic eligibility form the following important details are to be filled:

1. Name of HEI: The complete name of the HEI without abbreviations, as per affiliation letter for Colleges should be filled. (Also captured from Registration details).
2. City: Name of the city in which the HEI is situated should be filled.
3. State: Name of the state in which the HEI is situated should be filled as per letters of the name of the state and chosen from the suggestions displayed.
4. Date of establishment of the institution: Either the date of establishment is mentioned. Or the year of establishment of the HEI can be mentioned if date is not known.
5. Year of graduation of the last two batches: Latest two years of batches graduation HEI has to be mentioned in Year 1 text box & Year 2 text box respectively. If only one batch (2016) has graduated from the HEI till now, please mention only
